Little did Ders Anderson's family know when their prairie was started in 1981, that one ecological connection would lead to another and another. Today their restoration is just one part of a whole network of native plants, critters, fungi, and people. They don't think of their restoration as limited by property borders since their habitat is on the side of a moraine, atop shallow groundwater, and connected to one of the higher quality creeks in McHenry County. They own none of this, but their habitat influences all of it. Come learn about their 35-year story.
