- April 19, 8 a.m. — Crabtree Nature Center (3 Stover Road off of Palatine Road)
- May 3, 7:30 a.m. — Crabtree Nature Center (3 Stover Road off of Palatine Road)
- May 10, 7:30 a.m. — Deer Grove East\* (entrance on north side of Dundee Road, west of Hicks Road, east of Smith Street. Go to farthest parking area) with **optional extension** to Camp Alphonse (off Dundee Road)
- May 15, 3:30 p.m. - Baker's Lake for students and adults (parking lot on Highland Ave. south of Hillside Ave)
- May 17, 7:30 a.m.—Beverly Lake\* (parking lot on north side of Higgins Rd/Rt. 72, east of Rt. 25, west of Beverly Road)
- May 21, 7:30 a.m. — Crabtree Nature Center (3 Stover Road off of Palatine Road)
- May 24, 7:00 a.m.—Headwaters\* (parking lot on Wichman Rd. off north side of Rt. 72; ½ mile west of Rt. 59)
- June 5, 7:00 a.m.—Gallop Hill\* (meet at Penny Road Pond parking lot, less than a mile west of Old Sutton/Penny Rd intersection)
- June 16, 5:00 p.m. — Gallop Hill\* (as above)

\*indicates a more strenuous hike
